Re: Classification Code 8873 - Telecommuter Reassigned Employees
Discontinued for Use as of July 25, 2021

Members of the Rating Board:

I write to inform you that as of July 25, 2021, classification code 8873 – Telecommuter Reassigned Employees is discontinued for use.

Pursuant to the New York Workers' Compensation and Employers' Liability Manual Rule V(B)(4)(d) – Temporarily Reassigned Employees, use of classification code 8873 is not to exceed thirty (30) days after the expiration of an order by civil authorities. On March 7, 2020, Governor Cuomo issued Executive Order No. 202, declaring a State disaster emergency for the entire State of New York. Such Executive Order was last extended on May 25, 2021 for an additional thirty (30) days via Executive Order No. 202.109. On June 24, 2021, Executive Order No. 202.109 expired and the declaration of a State disaster emergency was not further extended. Accordingly, use of classification code 8873 cannot exceed thirty (30) days following the June 24, 2021 expiration of Executive Order No. 202.109 or July 25, 2021.
